

4. Discussion The Pressure of Conformity

Workbook pages 12-15. Discuss how chameleons change their color depending on what they're around. Share that people can be like that too...not our skin changing, but how we act can change. It's easy to conform to those you spend the most time around.

Ask yourself:

- "How do my friends affect me?
- "How do my friends affect me?
- Do they influence me for the better, or for the worse?"
- "Do my friends make good choices, or not very good choices?
- Do I want to act like them?"



Activity: Dino-Dough Race

Have a student volunteer come up to demonstrate conformity using Dino-Dough. Have the student use the Dino-Dough to make a rock in 20 seconds, then hold it up so everyone can see it. Now, have the students make the dough into a snake. Show the rest of the class. Ask the student if the Dino-Dough is easy or hard to squish into new things. Easy! Al-x, and all of us, are like Dino-Dough...it's easy for us to conform to what's around us, so let's choose friends who help us be our best selves.

7. Storytime

This is an extremely important part of the story. Tell it with great emotion and allow your children to respond.

8. Review

- What do we know? What did we learn tonight?
- Review conformity and how we become who we hang around.
- Make a big deal about the next part of the story! KEEP IT A SECRET AND BUILD SUSPENSE!
